Roundabout is based in South Yorkshire and works with young people aged 16-25 who are homeless or at risk of homelessness.

We provide shelter, support and life skills to help young people break the cycle of homelessness and live bright, independent futures. Every young person in South Yorkshire should be given a chance and an opportunity to turn their lives around, and not experience or re-experience homelessness.

We empower young people to break the cycle of homelessness by helping them develop long term independent living skills and support them with their education, employment and training needs. We want to be there for them in their time of need, as every young person deserves the chance to have a bright future.

We've found that problems can start to occur when life goes back to normal after Christmas in January - this was our busiest month this year, when 48 young people attended our drop-in advice service after experiencing problems at home.

"I became a peer educator so that I can help students understand the realities of youth homelessnesss and help other young people avoid even finding themselves in this situation. I want to tell young people that their mum asking them to nip to the shop isn't the worst thing in the world - just do it. I think that if someone had come to my school when I was 16 and told me their story, about how they ended up leaving home and how it all could've been avoided, I may not have been in the situation I'm in today."
